To Whom It May Concern:

The Ontario Transit Group (OTG) awarded Saskarc the Support of Excavation (SOE) scope for the supply and delivery of the temporary early works at the North Main Entry Station, which will become an integral part of the Ontario Metrolinx Subway line upon completion. The use of Saskarc's **infraMOD™** Design Methodology was essential in providing a steel design solution that reduced steel delivery and installation timelines, allowing site to safely progress with site excavations under tight time restrictions.

Saskarc has completed the following scopes:
